Job Summary:

This role involves harvest related activities on an on-call re-occurring cycle of approximately 4-6 days a month. Our Harvest Member should be a hardworking, trustworthy individual with a strong desire to grow plants and work in a greenhouse environment. This individual is responsible for horticultural duties associated with the harvest of plants and must maintain a positive work atmosphere by acting and communicating to team members, managers, clients, co-workers, and employees in a respectful manner. Candidates also may be considered for additional hours to temporarily assist with packaging requirements or for future full-time employment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Cleaning & preparation of rooms and equipment in a lab setting
- Maintain safe and clean work environment by practicing instructed use of all supplies, tools, equipment, and resources, while adhering to compliance with established policies and procedures
- Contribute to the completion of production plan by following scheduling and assignments, accomplishing work tasks, and following established priorities
- Follow company policies and procedures regarding work quality, dress code and regulatory compliance
- Harvesting and shipping support which includes picking, checking & packing
- Product packaging & general production support
- Perform miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned
- Maintain work flow by following standard operating procedures, contributing to the implementation of cost reductions, following reporting procedures and systems, practicing corrections to malfunctions within production process, and initiating and fostering a spirit of cooperation
- This position may require to sit; climb or balance; and stoop, kneel or crouch. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 10 pounds and occasionally lift and/or move up to 25 pounds
